Small Project Proposal Recap

Pollinator Garden

- First and second year students, enthusiastic
 - Fundraised last semester, earned \$300
- Concerns about the existence of bees on campus from Grounds
 - Pollinator bees are non aggressive
 - The garden would be located far away
 - Educational Opportunity
- Proposal was revisited and agreed to be funded
- Students have moved forward
 - Mobilized students to initial clearing cleaning
 - Talking about putting plants in the ground this Spring
 - Personal connection for acquiring plants

 - He'd agreed, we need to follow up.
 - Connect with Environmental Club?
 - They have a lot of projects going on themselves.
 - There is a National Organization – Bee City USA that can provide technical advice

 - Would attract all kinds of bees, but yes, some honey bees. Also mason bees. Butterflies, too
 - Bees would live elsewhere, no hives at the garden
